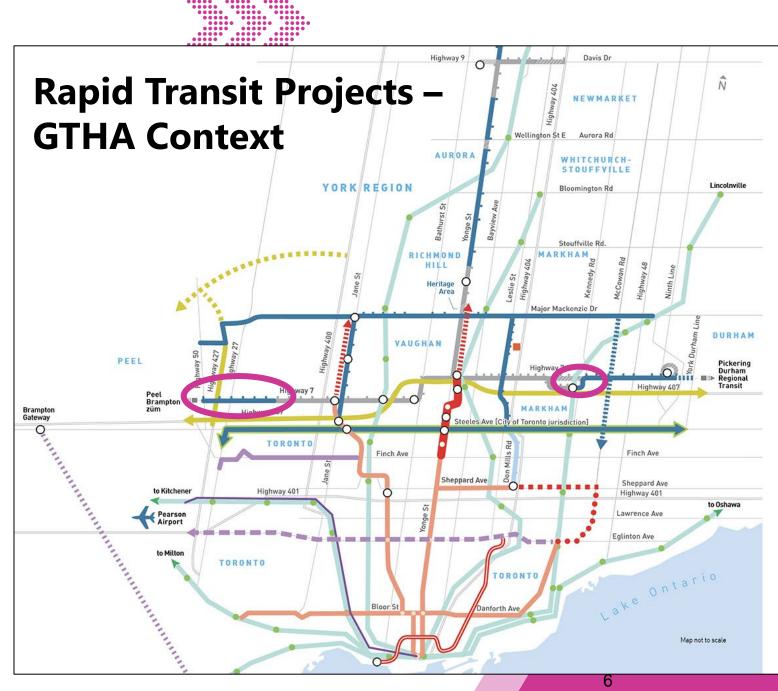

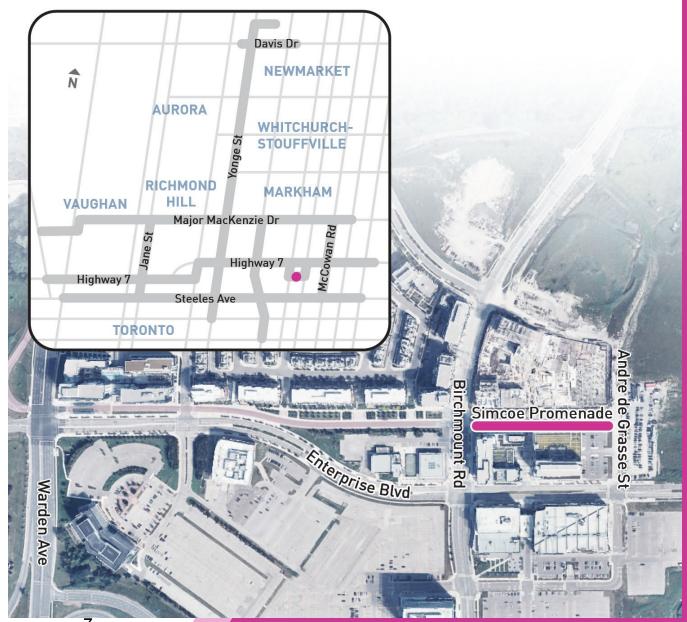

- Funding: \$2.4M capital cost; YRRTC 10-Year Capital Budget



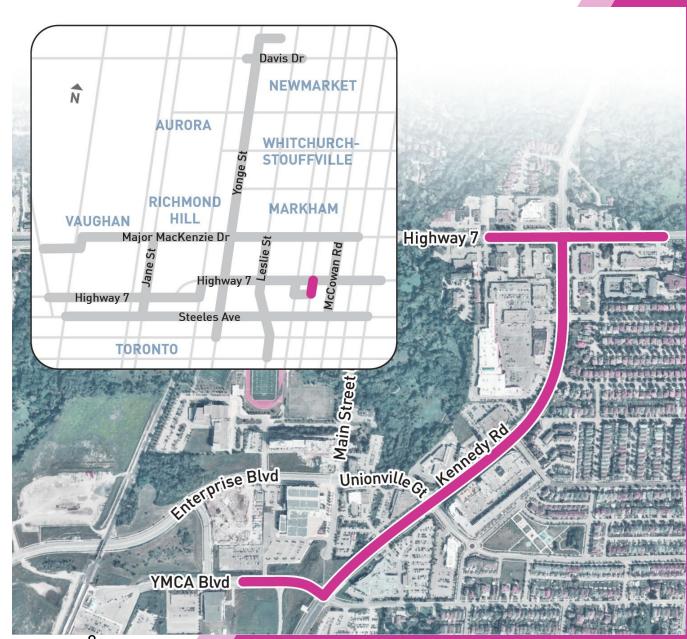

Life Cycle Stage 1 (Project Initiation & Planning)

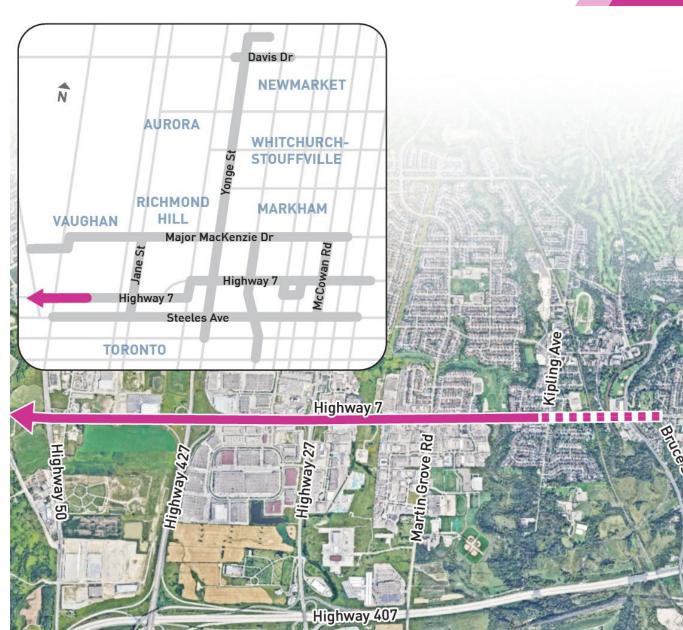
Lead: Metrolinx (Preliminary Design Business Case, Transit Project Assessment Process, Preliminary Design)

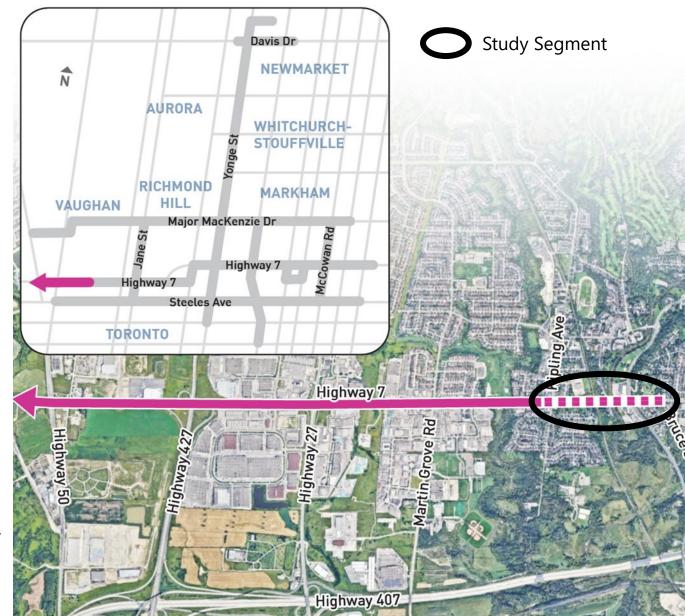


Hwy 7 West – Bruce St to Kipling Ave Feasibility Study

- Lead: York Region Public Works, in collaboration with Metrolinx
- Status: Technical assessment kick off meeting held to explore widening to 8 lanes (6 general purpose lanes + 2 BRT lanes + active transportation)

Next Steps:

- Data collection, options identification & assessment
- Study completion Q2/3 2024
- Funding: \$500k (upset limit) Feasibility Study; Public Works 10-Year Capital Budget
