

THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK

BYLAW NO. 2020-12

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2020-02 being a bylaw to levy against the lower-tier municipalities on an interim basis the sums of monies required during the year 2020 for the purposes of The Regional Municipality of York

WHEREAS on January 30, 2020, Council enacted Bylaw No. 2020-02 (the “Bylaw”) to provide for an interim levy against the lower-tier municipalities for monies required during 2020;

AND WHEREAS the Bylaw provides that the amounts payable are due in two (2) instalments of fifty percent (50%) each, the first such instalment payable on or before April 30, 2020 and the second instalment payable on or before June 30, 2020;

AND WHEREAS the lower-tier municipalities have implemented financial relief programs in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, including extending payment deadlines and waiving late payment penalties with respect to the payment of property taxes;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to support the local municipalities in their financial relief programs;

The Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

1. That, where any amount payable under subsection 2 (a) or (b) of the Bylaw is not remitted to the Region within the time set out in such subsection, no interest will be payable on any outstanding amount for a period of ninety (90) days following the due date.
2. That the Treasurer is authorized to extend the ninety (90) day period set out in Section 1 of this bylaw if deemed appropriate in the circumstances.
