December 13, 2018 - Regional Council Meeting -Communication Item F1 -

This City of Vaughan communication deals with a York Region Council resolution made at the Council Meeting of September 20, 2018, and the City of Vaughan's support resolution, from the Vaughan City Council meeting of September 27, 2018

A letter sent by York Region Chair Emmerson on December 4, 2018 to Ministry of Transportation Minster Jeff Yurek, was missing the point raised by both Councillor Rosati on September 20, 2018 and more clearly spelled out in the City of Vaughan resolution of September 27, 2018.

On November 13, 2018 - Keep York Moving, a York Region citizen's based group, which is replacing the South Central York Region - Congestion Relief Committee, sent a letter to Minister Yurek, on specific short term, low-cost, public transit solutions, the Provincial Government should consider as it develops its new Public Transit Policy.

On December 5, Keep York Moving met with York Region MPP's and/or their Executive/Legislative Assistants from 8 out of 10 York Region Provincial ridings to give them background to the November 13, 2018 letter, support Chairman Emmerson's letter of December 4, 2018 and make sure that a message of restoring 1 fare, direct bus service to York University was clearly communicated, with rationale

My request is a resolution to for York Region Council is to;

- clarify their direction to staff,
- update the letter to Minster Yurek
- clearly communicate the principle that the opening of the new subway should not add more time, more cost and more danger to commuters, Students, Faculty and Staff who used bus routes which serviced the York University Campus directly prior to September 2, 2018..
- direct staff to restore YRT Bus Service to campus by January 5, 2019
