

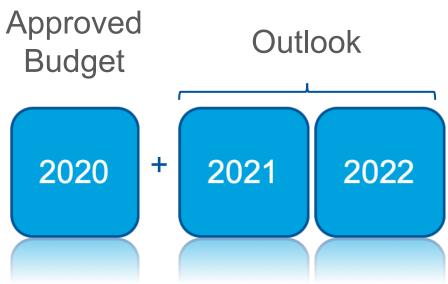

2020 APPROVED BUDGET AND ENDORSED OUTLOOK





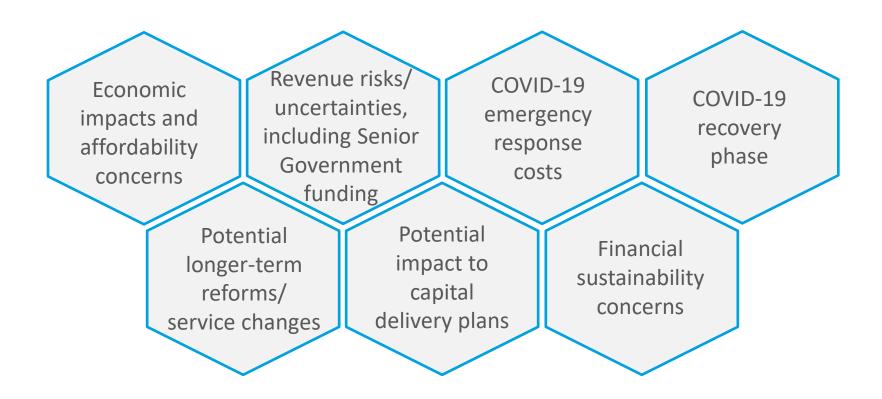

RELIEF MEASURES TO SUPPORT BUSINESSES AND RESIDENTS

April 2, 2020:

Council approved retaining the 2020 water and wastewater rates at their 2019 levels

April 30, 2020:

Council approved waiving interest until December 31, 2021 on any portion of property tax instalments, for the 2020 taxation year, not remitted to the Region as a direct result of a local municipality's COVID-19 tax relief program, except for the interest related to the final 2020 installment which shall be waived until March 31, 2021
