## Brief summary of issue or purpose of deputation:

Dear York Region Council Members,

First thank you for carefully considering my submission.

My family and I are residents of East Gwillimbury.

The people of Ontario have been in vast majority, very compliant with the recommended medical guidelines in place. As a result of this compliance and the epidemiological curve there has been a steady decrease in cases in York Region as shown on the York Region public health website.

Actually the York Region public health and Ontario public health have been very strong with their robust testing and have been orchestrating very thorough contact tracing to contain the spread of this particular virus and any outbreaks that will occur. As they continue to give the best advice for Ontarians and York Region residents.

I would like to make three points:

Thirdly, to force children to wear masks above the age of two is not recommended by the COVID19 guidelines set out by the Hospital for Sick Children. Again the health professionals should be followed in their recommendations for the health and safety of our children.
