Dear Council Members,

As a family physician on the front-lines of COVID 19, I have witnessed first-hand how this disease and the collateral harms from this public health crisis have disproportionately affected essential workers and those whom our society relies upon for daily essentials of living.

As the economy reopens, and these people at the front lines of food and service industries are exposed to larger numbers of the public coming out of lockdown, I implore you to be on the right side of history and pass the mandate for masking to set a clear, unequivocal expectation that those who can mask (allowing for appropriate exceptions) do mask in a all high risk public spaces. This will protect all workers on the front lines of grocery stores, hardware stores, restaurants, postal offices and other services, as well as their patrons.
