Dear Christopher Raynor:

This week, the Georgina Chamber of Commerce sent out an email to our members asking business representatives in our community their thoughts on a mandatory mask/face covering bylaw. This, in advance of the special York Region Council meeting being held on Thursday July 9<sup>th</sup> to review reports and make decisions on the topic.

With a brief explanation of the report and recommendations being discussed at the upcoming Council meeting, our Chamber asked our members (business owners and representatives): Are you in favour of the Region introducing a bylaw requiring the wearing of face coverings or masks mandatory in York Region? The Chamber received 139 responses to our survey, of which 89 voted in favour of a mandatory bylaw. This works out to 64% in favour. It should be noted, while only 45% of the emails sent were opened, 99% of those opened responded to the survey. Never has the Georgina Chamber had this type of response.

Our organization knows this is a matter that requires serious consideration and we wanted York Region Council armed with as much information as possible, including the thoughts of our Georgina business community.
