






This is a legal notice that could lead to you being evicted from your home.			
The following information is from your languord

If another rent payment becomes due on or before the date you make the above payment to your landlord, you must also pay this extra amount.			
WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW			
The following information is provided by the Landlord and Tenant Board			
The termination date	The date that the landford gives you in this notice to pay or move out must be at least:  14 days after the landford gives you the notice, if you rent by the month or year, or 7 days after the landford gives you the notice, if you rent by the day or week.		
What if you agree with the notice?	If you agree that you owe the amount that the landlord is claiming, you should pay this amount by the termination date in this notice. If you do so, the landlord cannot apply to the Board to eyict you based on this notice.		
If you do not pay the amount owing, you do not have to move out. However, the landl can apply to the Board to evict you. If the landlord applies to the Board to evict you ar Board orders the eviction, you will likely have to pay the landlord's filing fee, in addition what you owe.		the landlord applies to the Board to evict you and the	
What if you disagree with the notice?	You do not have to move out if you disagree with this notice. You could talk to your landlord. You may also want to get legal advice. If you cannot work things out, the landlord may apply to the Board for an order to evict you. The Board will schedule a hearing where you can explain why you disagree.		
What if you move out?	If you move out by the termination date in this notice, your tenancy will end on the termination date. However, you may still owe money to your landlord. Your landlord will not be able to apply to the Board but they may still take you to Court for this money.
