As president for the Mackenzie Ridge Ratepayers Association, I represent a large area of the Maple community. We are against the conversion of Vaughan Employment Lands to Residential Lands – V2 and V7

This valuable designation is intended to provide space for important future employment opportunities and must be maintained.
