

2016 Census Data; See "Profile of Children in York Region" for additional data


Impact of COVID-19 on Children 0-12

#### In York Region:

- ✓ Closure of 540 child care centres impacting 57,000 children
- ✓ Abrupt end of in-person therapy and monitoring for more than 2,000 children with special needs
- √ 70 EarlyON programs closed their doors.
- ✓ Capacity building sessions for early-learning professionals were cancelled



# The Value of Investing in Children


#### **Early Learning Program Outcomes**

- √ \$7 return on every \$1 invested\*
- ✓ Children are less likely to require social assistance, experience homelessness or incarceration as adults
- ✓ Improved mental health for children

- ✓ Increases community connections, decreases social isolation for parents
- ✓ Improves labour market participation for parents
- ✓ Helps reduce income inequality

70,000 children across York Region received direct or indirect early childhood supports annually

In February 2020, 8,887 children received subsidized child care
