# LEGISLATED WEB AND WEB CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

- All websites and web content must meet Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0, Level AA requirements by January 1, 2021
- Applies to public facing websites owned and managed by York Region and York Regional Police
- Do not apply to password protected or Intranet sites

- 12 Guidelines
- 61 Success Criteria



### WCAG 2.0 EXPLAINED

#### **EXAMPLES OF LEVEL A:**

- Text descriptions of images so users with vision disabilities can understand what the image represents
- Web content that can be changed to large print so a user can read the content with ease


Adult Day Programs

### WCAG 2.0 EXPLAINED

**EXAMPLES OF LEVEL AA:** 

- Headings and labels that help users navigate and find content with minimal barriers
- Color-contrast of 3:1 on navigational graphics to help users with vision disabilities


