Re: Automated Speed Enforcement Update

This memorandum advises Council the two-year limited use automated speed enforcement (ASE) pilot will commence on select Regional roads during November 2020.

The Region's automated speed enforcement camera has been delivered and will become operational on Regional roads during November 2020

Staff has been working with the supplier, Redflex Traffic Systems Limited (Redflex) to expedite delivery of the Region's ASE camera. Redflex has successfully sourced the camera and Staff are currently working with Redflex to perform equipment and image quality testing in advance of activation. The ASE program is a two-year limited-use pilot on Regional roads beginning November. The updated ASE schedule is included as Attachment 1.

Staff will report back on the two-year pilot on the technology and volume impacts on the Region's Provincial Offences Courts

The two-year limited use ASE pilot will allow evaluation of the technology and service provided by Redflex and the number of charges and rate at which these are disputed to be assessed on the volume impact on Court Services. Staff will also monitor the impact of ASE in reducing speeding in Community Safety Zones.

Preliminary findings will be reported to Council in 2021 and all aspects of the program will be shared with our local municipal partners.
