## RE: Timing for Blue Box Transition to Full Producer Responsibility

For your information and records, at its electronic meeting held on May 5, 2020 the Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacted as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT Community Infrastructure & Environmental Services Report CIES2020-007, dated May 5, 2020, entitled "Timing for Blue Box Transition to Full Producer Responsibility", be received; and

THAT as requested by AMO, the Town of East Gwillimbury confirm that the preferred date to transition to full producer responsibility for collection of Blue Box material is on December 31, 2025 coinciding with the end of the current Northern Six (N6) waste collection contract; and
