

## **Greening the Region's Transportation Services Fleets**

On June 25, 2020 Regional Council made the following decision:

- Council refer the following recommendations to staff with a further report to be brought forward in fall 2020 with more detailed analysis related to the cost impacts of climate change, multi-year financial information and several options for moving forward:
  - Council endorse the plan documented in this report for York Region Transit to transition the bus fleet from diesel to a greenhouse gas emission-free electric propulsion system by 2051. The Plan implementation would be subject to ongoing monitoring of the electric bus technical performance, long-term cost implications and future Council budget approval.
  - 2. Council endorse the development of a greening strategy for the non-transit fleet with staff reporting the details of the strategy in fall 2020.
- 2. Council endorse revisions to Transit's procurement strategy for 2021 bus replacements to include six electric buses with associated charging infrastructure using capital dollars currently allocated to the bus replacement program.
