

Economic Vitality and Good Government

- Manage and disseminate **185** flood line maps and hydrologic/hydraulic modeling for York Region
- Advance construction of TRCA's new administrative building including structural timber installation and geothermal installation
- Support York Region's waste diversion goals through PPG's Material Exchange program
- Monitor approximately 540 infrastructure hazard sites and prioritize sites for protection works
- Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Funding (DMAF) to support implementation of 1 infrastructure protection project in addition to the planning of 2 others
- Support the stormwater management pond maintenance and assessments

Sustainable Environment

SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONMENT

- Plant approximately 45,000 trees and shrubs on private and public land in York Region
- Collect data at approximately 120 monitoring stations in York Region for the Regional Watershed Monitoring Program
- Deliver 20 Living Labs tours to post-secondary students and professionals to grow awareness of sustainability and climate change issues
- Map, monitor, and manage forest resources and hazardous trees for 20 km of trail and 50 km of boundary on TRCA-owned lands
- Finalize the TRCA Invasive Species
 Management Strategy and associated tools to facilitate implementation with input from internal and external partners
- Operate and maintain 10 climate stations, including snow, temperature and meteorological stations



Healthy Communities

HEALTHY COMMUNITIES

- Engage 500 participants in the Multicultural Connections Program
- Monitor and maintain 170 km of trail in York Region
- Deliver education programs to 2,700 students including the Watershed on Wheels program and Aquatic Plants program
- Engage over 200 participants through the East Humber Community Environmental Enhancement Program
- Organize and deliver 8 residential workshops focused on storm water management and native plant gardening for residents
- Support the implementation of water quality improvement projects through the Rural Clean Water Program



COVID-19 Update

- TRCA continues to regularly analyze operations to mitigate the direct impacts of the pandemic while maximizing TRCAs revenue generation potential.
- TRCA is adapting programs and services to align with Provincial directives and best practices related to the pandemic to ensure safety of all employees and stakeholders.
- Authority Generated revenue has been, and will continue to be, affected by the pandemic including reductions in user fees inclusive of public use facilities, education programming and events.

- Urban forest studies for Richmond Hill and Markham


Natural Cover Quantity

 - Additional inspection, engineering analysis and capital works intervention at high priority sites
 - Enhanced minor maintenance program

Implementation of reforestation, wetland restoration, meadow management, and invasive treatment components from the updated restoration and management plan










- Ongoing support to advance projects within the Vaughan Metropolitan Centre, Markham Langstaff Gateway and Markham Urban Growth Centre




- TRCA hosted 66 Facebook live events achieving 98,346 views as part of the At Home with Nature series, in 2020
