This note is intended to urge the regional councillors not to support the plans for the 413 highway in its present form.

From the information that I have read over the last year, I do not believe that the proposed plan and route for the highway is in the best interests of Vaughan or York Region.

My concerns are as follows:

- significant loss of prime greenbelt and agricultural lands
- lack of justification / need for the project especially in light of a \$6 Billion +++ price tag
- would actually worsen the traffic and congestion in the north west part of Vaughan
- fear that #413 will worsen the already worrisome urban spread
- bull dozing / fast tracking of environmental assessments and protocols
- impact (environmental and cost) of crossing 85 streams and river valleys
- lack of considerations for other alternatives make better use of 407ETR (subsidize truck traffic) ... shift route further north possibility even using Highway 9 Corridors etc
- disregard for previous studies that said that the EA and economics of the 413 were flawed ... prompting the prev govt to cancel the project .
- perception (real or imagined ?) that 413 is being pushed to reward developers and construction groups

I urge the Regional Councillors to with hold or withdraw support for the 413 Highway. This has already been done by municipalities along the proposed route.
