Re: proposed GTA West Corridor (Highway 413)

I am writing at this time to encourage you to oppose the proposed GTA West Corridor. Here is my rationale for making this request:

- We currently have a tolled east-west corridor, Highway 407, which is under used;
- Research had shown that building Highway 413 will save commuters from 30 to 60 seconds in travel time, hardly worth the estimated \$10 Billion to build it;
