

### ADVISORY COMMITTEE — FARM 911 THE EMILY PROJECT

#### • Farm 911 – The Emily Project

- Brought forward by Kim Empringham
- Farm accidents can occur in remote locations
- Many vacant rural and farm properties lack civic address signage
- Project in response to an on-farm accident involving a child
- Partnership with local Federation of Agriculture
- <u>Action from Dec 2, 2020</u>: Referred to staff for further investigation and report back at future meeting.

### FARM 911 THE EMILY PROJECT — STAFF UPDATE

- Conducting research and information gathering
  - Durham Region Meeting December 10, 2020
  - King Township Meeting January 8, 2021
  - Town of East Gwillimbury Meeting January 19, 2021
  - Town of Georgina Meeting January 20, 2021
  - York Region Transportation February 24, 2021 \*New
  - York Region Community Health Services (CHS) Paramedics and Senior Services – March 4, 2021 \*New
  - Local Municipality Fire and Emergency Services March 15, 2021
     \*New

## **RESEARCH FINDINGS — FARM 911 EMILY PROJECT**

- Researched Durham, Peel, Halton, Niagara and York Regions
  - Only Durham Region has adopted the Farm 911/ The Emily Project at Regional level (February 26, 2020) – led by Finance Department
  - Implementation is championed at local municipal level
- In most cases, a local municipality led initiative
  - Examples: Town of Caledon
  - Town of Pelham, Town of Wainfleet, and Town of Grimsby
- Partnership with local Federation of Agriculture (OFA)
- Multi-disciplinary staff involvement

## MEETING SUMMARY — FARM 911 EMILY PROJECT

#### York Region Transportation

- Not involved with local municipality civic address signage programs
- York Region Community Health Services (CHS) Paramedics and Senior Services
  - Collaborative response with York Region Police and local Fire & Emergency services
  - Current technology through Provincial Dispatch Centre does not allow direct geo-location / PIN
  - Rely on mixed tools with partners to attend to scene of accident (e.g., physical landmarks, technology and signage)
  - Work with cell phone carriers for an approximate location (triangulation)
  - Provincial implementation of "Next Generation 911" aimed by 2023
- Local Municipality Fire and Emergency Services

### YORK REGION ANALYSIS — FARM 911 EMILY PROJECT

- One local municipality has adopted the Farm 911 Emily Project
  - Town of Georgina (May 6, 2020; By-Law Number 2020 0028). Uptake has been slow.
  - Township of King is exploring the initiative
- Most local municipalities have the Green (911) Signage Program (or municipal civic signage) for occupied properties
  - Township of King
  - Town of East Gwillimbury
  - Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville
  - City of Markham
  - City of Vaughan


