RE: REQUEST FOR A TEMPORARY POP-UP CLINIC

For your information and records, at its electronic meeting held on May 4, 2021 the Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacted as follows:

WHEREAS the Holland Landing postal code L9N in East Gwillimbury has been identified as an emerging hot spot with increasing rates of COVID-19 infection, and

WHEREAS this area also hosts a number of workplaces and retailers that serve a greater regional population, and

WHEREAS Council recognizes that vaccine supply and staffing limitations render a permanent vaccine clinic located in East Gwillimbury a challenging initiative at this time,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury support Mayor Hackson's request that a temporary pop-up clinic be implemented by York Region Public Health in the Town of East Gwillimbury to address the pressing need to improve vaccination rates in this emerging hot spot.
