

Community Safety and Well-being Plan for York Region:

Consultation Highlights and Key Themes

The *Police Services Act, 1990* requires single-tier and regional municipalities to prepare and adopt a Community Safety and Well-being Plan.

York Region is in the process of developing its first Community Safety and Well-being Plan, which will strengthen our relationships and how we collaborate and coordinate services with community partners on issues related to safety and well-being.

Between August 2020 and March 2021, over **700** members of the public and stakeholders from across York Region participated in the engagement process, including through online surveys and iterative rounds of virtual consultations.
