

Memorandums of Understanding with Conservation Authorities and Changes to the Conservation Authorities Act

On May 27, 2021 Regional Council made the following decision:

- Council direct staff to work with the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority and the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority to update the current Memorandum of Understanding for Planning and Development Review to provide for efficient, timely, and cost-effective services.
- That staff report back to Council on regulations related to the Conservation
 Authorities Act once released by the Province and any changes to York Region's
 current Memorandums of Understanding and Service Level Agreements.
- 3. The Regional Clerk circulate this report to the Chief Administrative Officers of Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority and the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority, the Clerks of the local municipalities, and the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks for information.
