Dear Committee Members,

First, a recognition to each of you for the important work you undertake for your respective communities and for the Region of York overall; it is appreciated.

We are respectfully submitting this in writing given scheduling conflicts.

Prior to the completion of the Transportation Services report, and with the information we had at the time, we had submitted a Deputation Request to present to the Committee of the Whole regarding Speed Limit Revisions at Mt. Albert Rd. and Warden Avenue in East Gwillimbury. This was regarding speed limits and safety concerns, and we wanted to be sure to have this matter addressed in the September meeting.

Since then, York Region Transportation Services staff have been working further to address the concerns; we are aware that their study and assessment of the issue was multifold and thorough,

and that it involved diligent review and collaboration. We are also aware that their recommendation for the speed limit revision in this area has been made accordingly, as noted in the report that they have submitted for your review.

We effectively believe the speed limit reduction, as they recommend, to 60 km, and its subsequent enforcement, will address the concern for everyone's safety and wellbeing. As residents, we are appreciative of the collaboration this required, and duly note the exceptional work done.

We do believe a vote in favour of the recommendation is warranted on behalf of the safety of the community altogether, and thank you for your thoughtful consideration in this matter. Thank you.
