



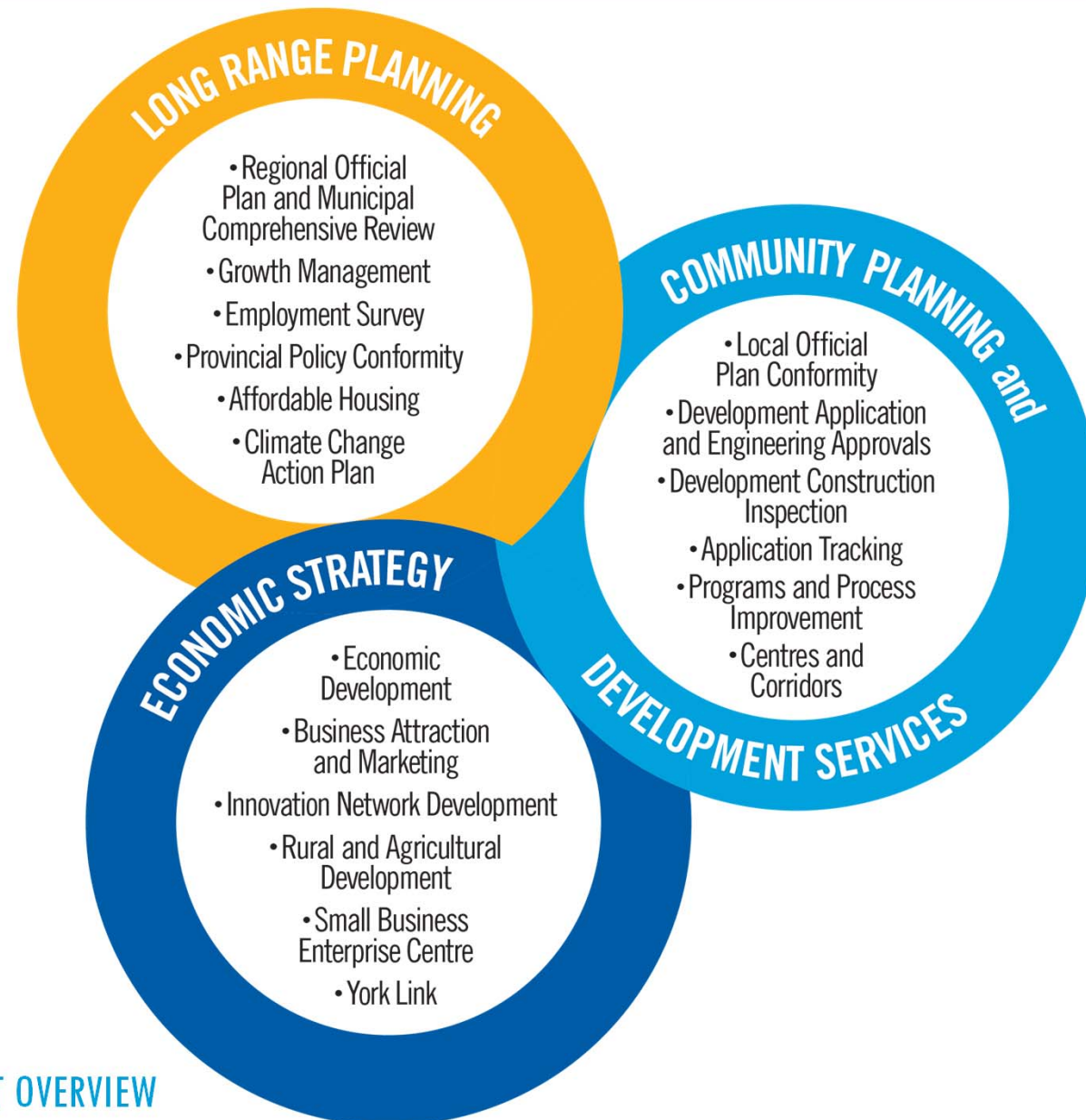

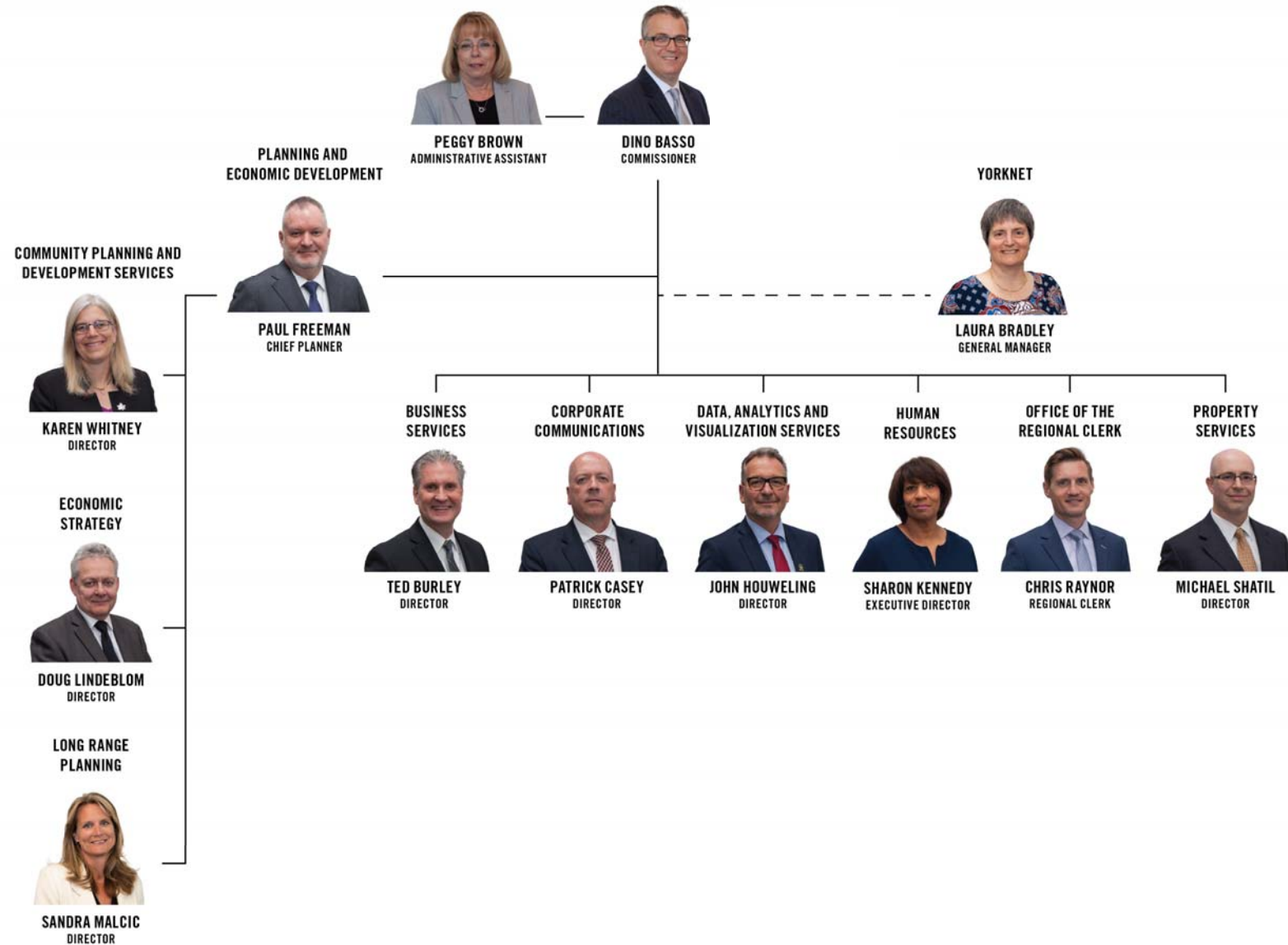
Planning Advisory Committee

- Three members of Council including the Regional Chair, and eight members of the public

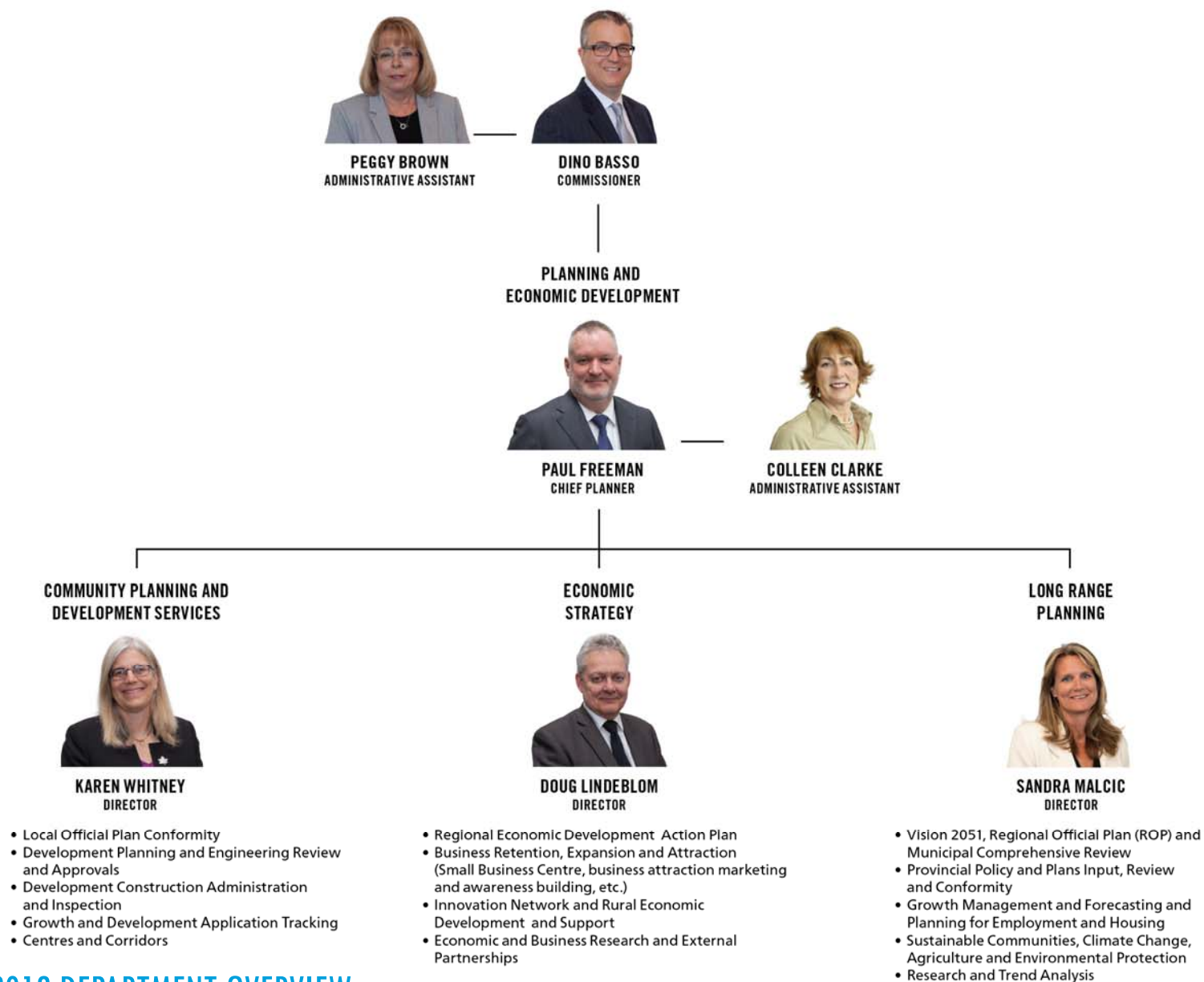
York Region Agricultural Advisory Liaison Group

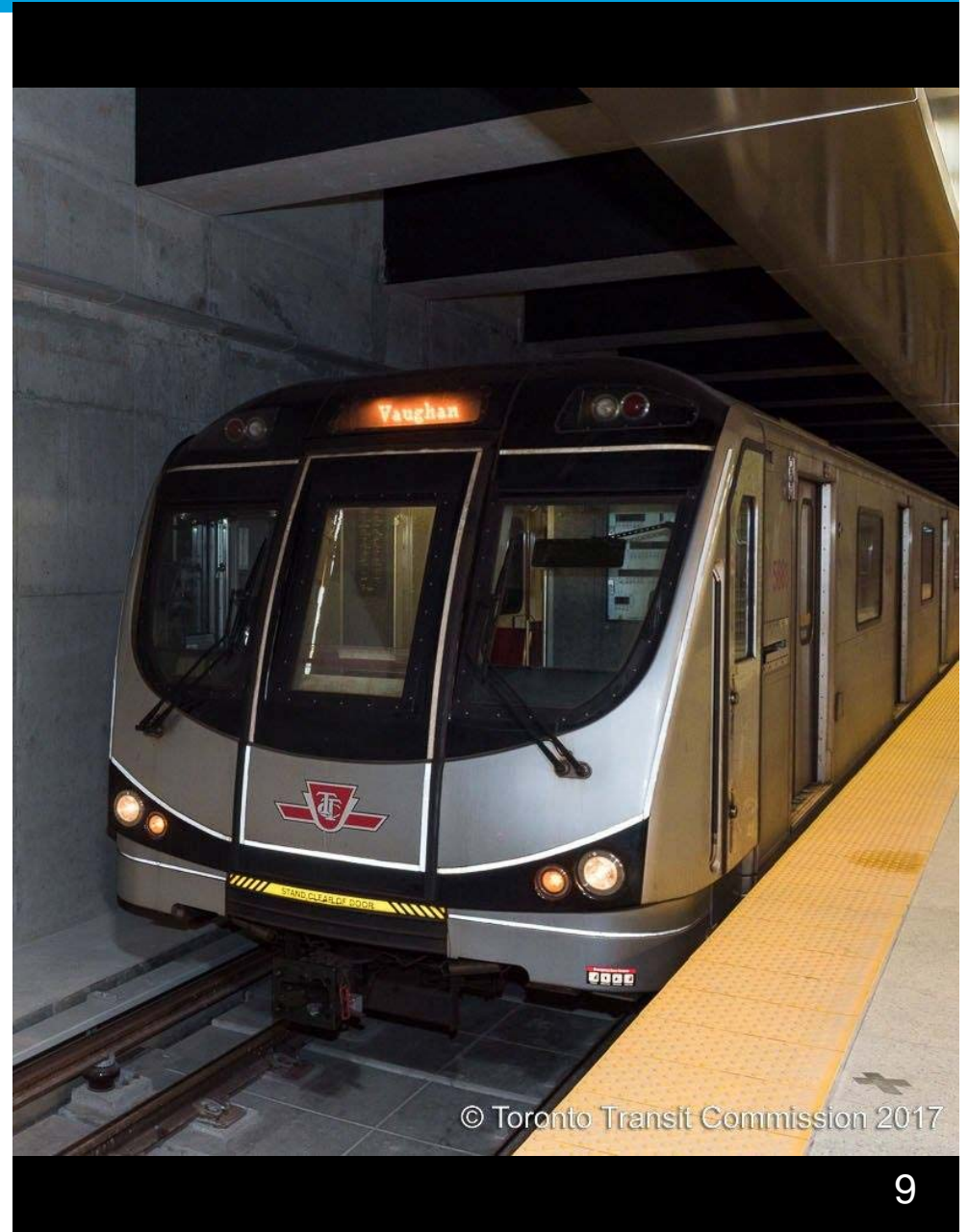
Modified York Region Official Plan - 2010

The first subway in York Region opened at the Vaughan Metropolitan Centre in December 2017

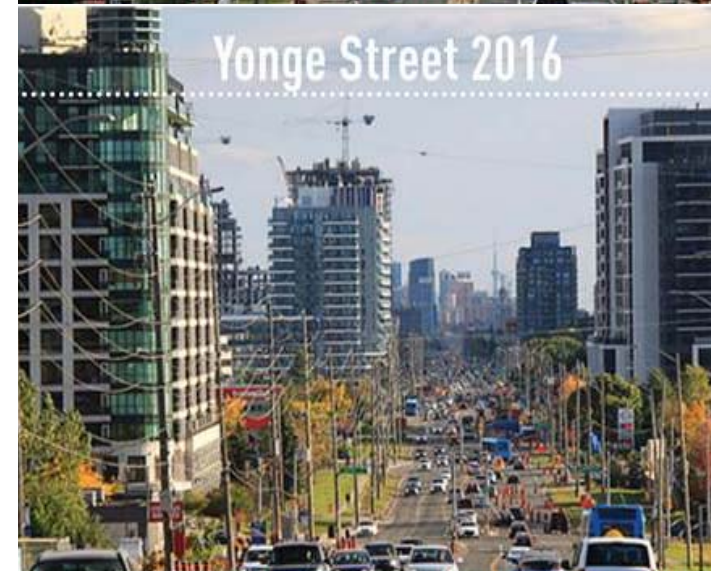

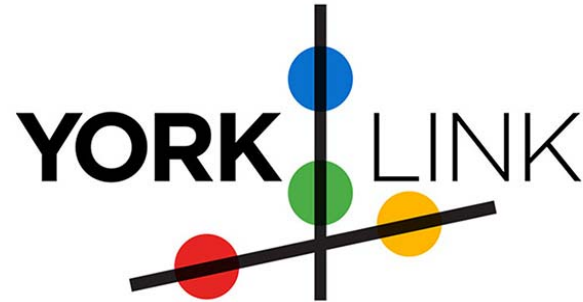
