2. That the Chief Administrative Officer report to the November Special

Council meeting with recommendations for appropriate developer front-funding financing to implement the Upper York Sewage Solution and contribute to York Region's financing requirements, including the Yonge Street Subway extension.

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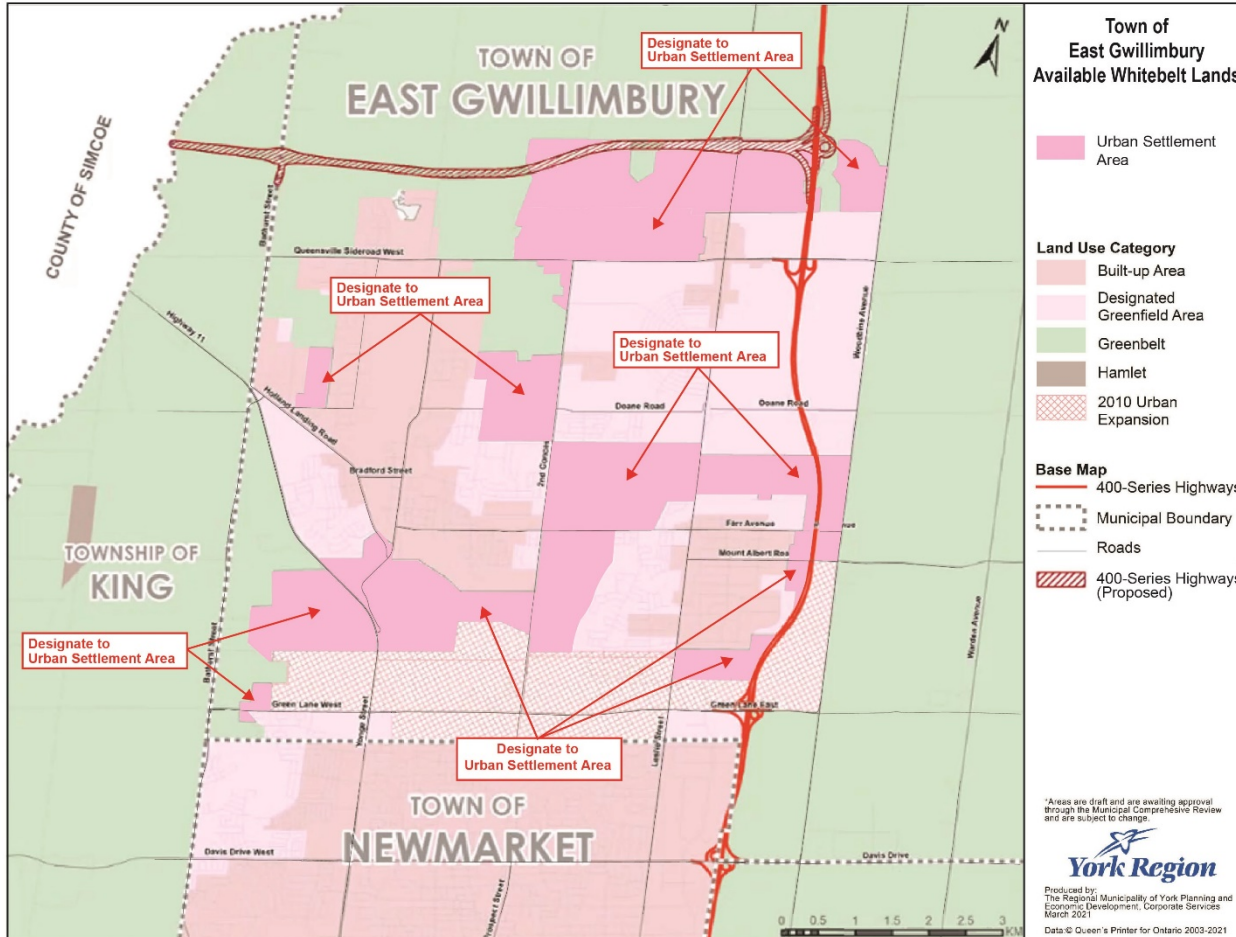
