

## Yonge North Subway Extension Transit-Oriented Communities

On April 28, 2022 Regional Council made the following decision:

- 1. That Council receive the report dated April 22, 2022 from the Commissioner of Corporate Services and the Chief Planner.
- 2. That Council adopt the following resolution:

Whereas the Region appreciates the Province advancing the YNSE project including the five stations being Bridge, Clark, High Tech, Royal Orchard and Steeles;

Whereas Enhanced Minister's Zoning Orders (eMZOs) for the City of Markham (O. Reg. 345/22) and the City of Richmond Hill (O. Reg. 344/22) were issued on April 14, 2022; and

Whereas the Province is asking York Region to enter into a Transit-Oriented Communities (TOC) agreement in principle by April 29, 2022 that sets out the TOC process and future requirements.

## Therefore be it resolved that:

- Council authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to finalize negotiations and execute the Transit-Oriented Communities Programmatic Agreement-In-Principle, to advance Provincial commitment in funding and delivery of Royal Orchard Station.
- Council direct staff to negotiate draft terms in the Transit-Oriented Communities site-specific Memorandums of Understanding with the Province to protect Regional interests and bring final agreements and Memorandums of Understanding to Council for consideration and endorsement.
- 3. The Regional Clerk circulate this report to the Ministries of Infrastructure, Transportation, and Municipal Affairs and Housing, and Cities of Markham, Richmond Hill, and Vaughan.
