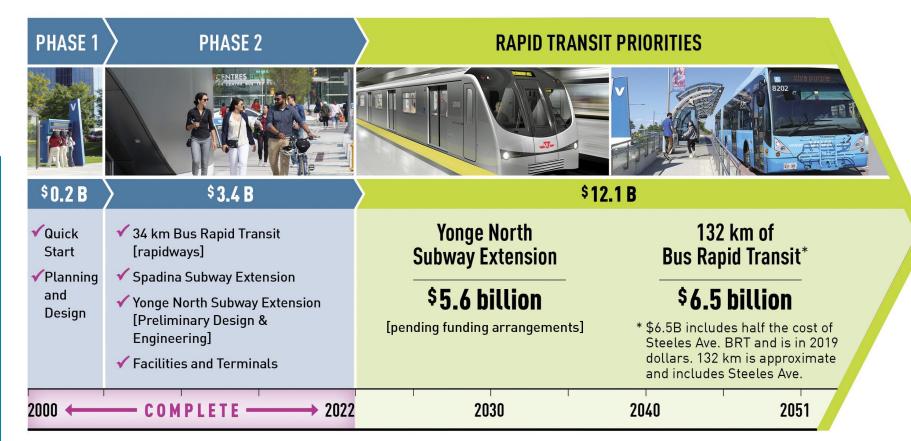

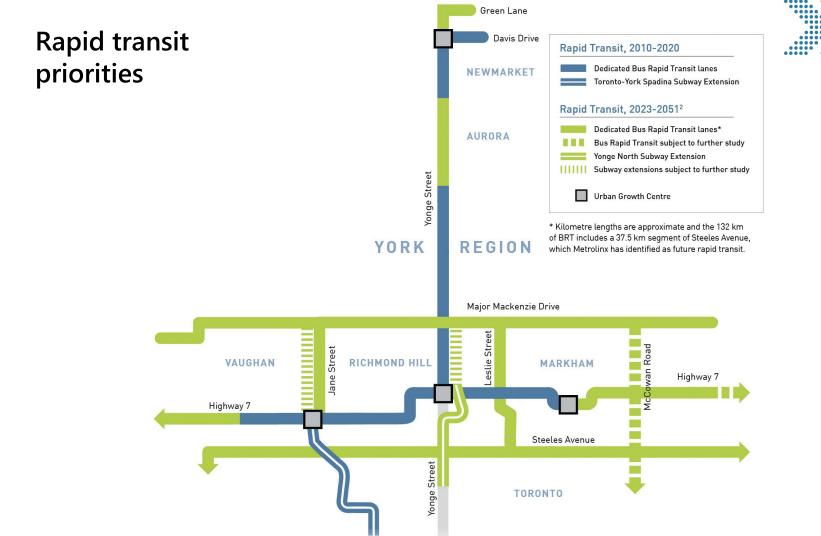

# Key highlights of the Multi-Year Budget



#### **Optimizing Yonge North Subway Extension investment**

- Advancing the Region's interests
- Leading technical reviews
- Leading design, service & community integration & TOC considerations
- Coordination & integration between provincial agencies, Region & local municipalities



#### Advancing the next generation of BRT projects

- Pursuing funding to complete network
- Planning & designing BRT corridors to maintain a state of readiness
- Constructing BRT corridors in partnership with others
- Connecting key corridors, transit & subways



#### **Resourcing to support Subway and BRT programs**

- Leveraging internal & external funding availability for YRRTC & Regional staff recoveries
- Identification & provision of professional services needed to support efficient delivery of these programs
- Providing advisory services to stakeholders & partners

# **Budget Assumptions**

#### **Capital Budget – Yonge North Subway Extension**

- Region's share of \$1.12B is included in YRRTC's 10-year capital program
- Program management costs of \$55.6M is required to advance Regional interests
- All Regional YNSE costs will be funded through the 2022 DC Bylaw Update (75%) & Tax Levy (25%)
- Potentially supplemented with the Rapid Transit Infrastructure Levy

## **Capital Budget – BRT**

- Region's share of the 10-year BRT program will be funded through the 2022 DC Bylaw Update (82%) & Tax Levy (18%)
- Potentially supplemented with the Rapid Transit Infrastructure Levy, starting in 2025

#### **Operating Budget – YNSE & BRT**

- Resources will be recovered through Tax Levy, Regional DCs, Rapid Transit Infrastructure Levy and/or Provincial agencies
- Additional staffing requirements will be advanced annually, subject to funding

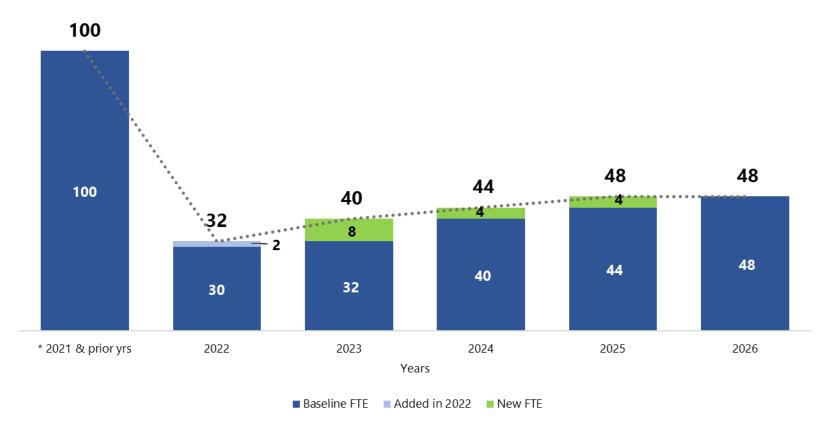






# **YRRTC** Resourcing Needs

#### > Provincial:

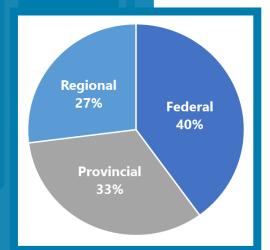
- Frequent Rapid Transit Network Program (Metrolinx)

- 10-Year Capital Plan

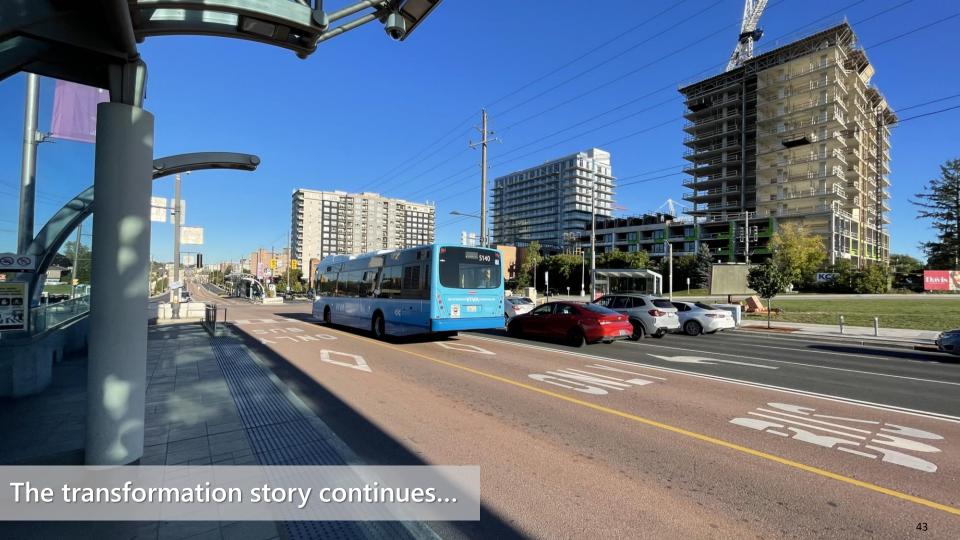
#### **>** Private:
