**Re: Notification regarding Mayor Hackson's Short-Term Leave of Absence and Appointment of Alternate Member of Regional Council**

For your information and records, at its special meeting of Municipal Council held on November 2, 2023, the Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacted as follows:

***Whereas** Mayor Hackson has advised that due to a short-term medical leave, she will be absent from the meetings of council for up to three successive months commencing with her planned absence effective November 2, 2023;*

***Whereas** Section 259(1)(c) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that the office of a member of council becomes vacant if the member is absent from the meetings of council for three successive months without being authorized to do so by a resolution of council; and*

***Be it therefore resolved** that the Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury hereby authorizes Mayor Hackson to be absent from meetings of council for up to three successive months effective November 2, 2023, in accordance with Section 259(1)(c) of the Municipal Act, 2001.*

The Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury further enacted as follows:

***Be it resolved** that the regional alternate be selected from the 2022-2026 Rotational Acting Mayor Schedule; and*

***That** Councillor Crone is hereby appointed as the Town of East Gwillimbury's Alternate Member of Regional Council for the 2022-2026 Term of Council, expiring on November 14, 2026; and*

***That** Council enact By-law 2023-077 to appoint an Alternate Member of Regional Council for the 2022-2026 term; and*

***That** in accordance with the Regional Municipality of York's guidelines for Alternate Members of Council, a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Regional Clerk.*
