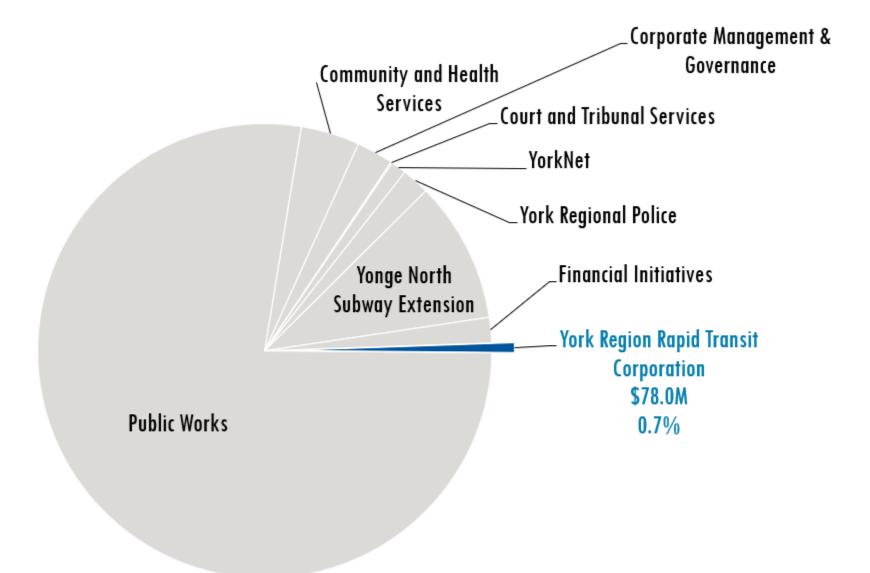

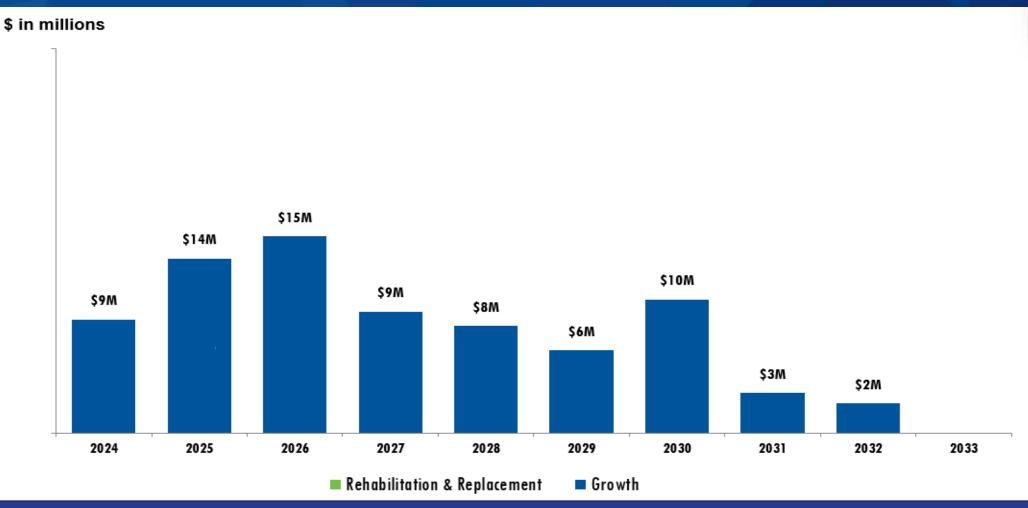
TEN-YEAR CAPITAL PLAN IS 0.7% OF THE REGION'S PLAN





2024 CAPITAL PLAN BY CATEGORY



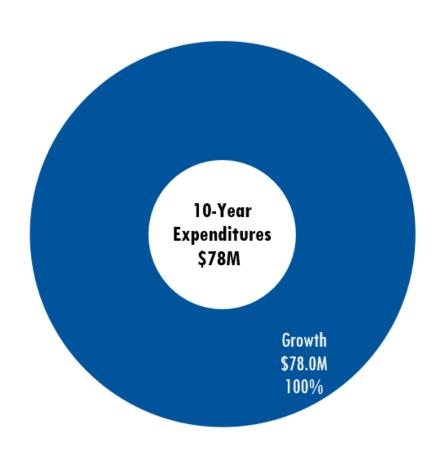


YRRTC's 2024 10-year Capital Plan is \$78M; 100% is for growth related projects

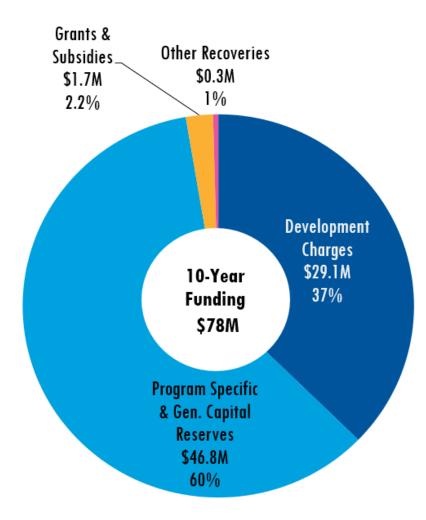
CAPITAL EXPENDITURES AND FUNDING

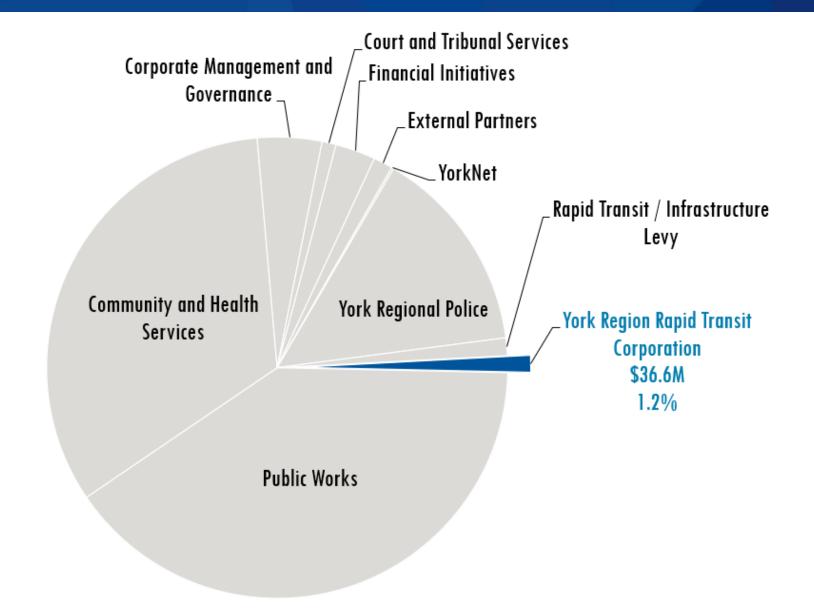

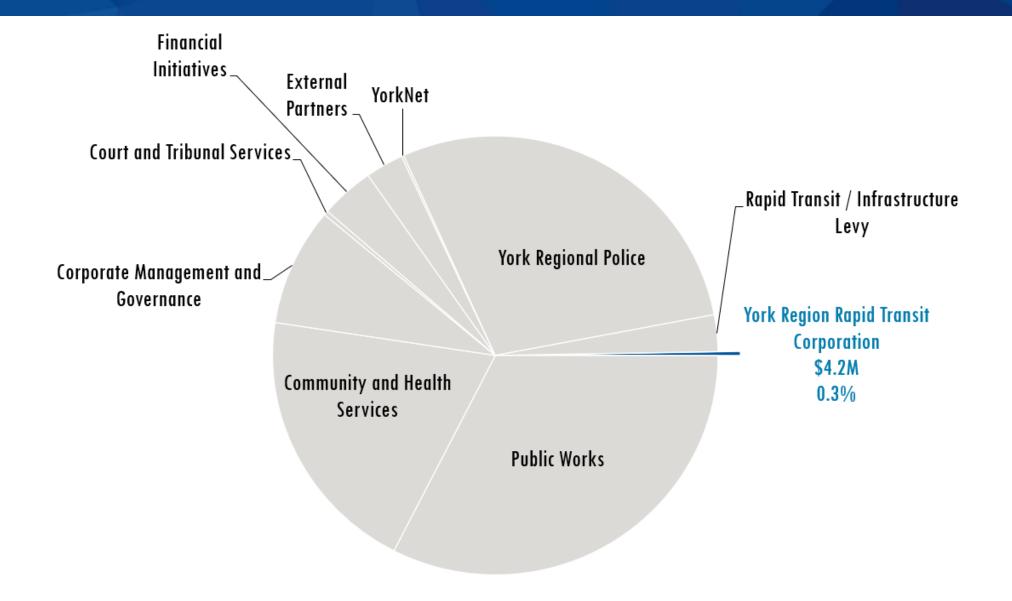
YRRTC's BUDGET IS 1.2% OF THE REGION'S EXPENDITURES





YRRTC'S BUDGET IS 0.3% OF THE REGION'S TAX DOLLAR



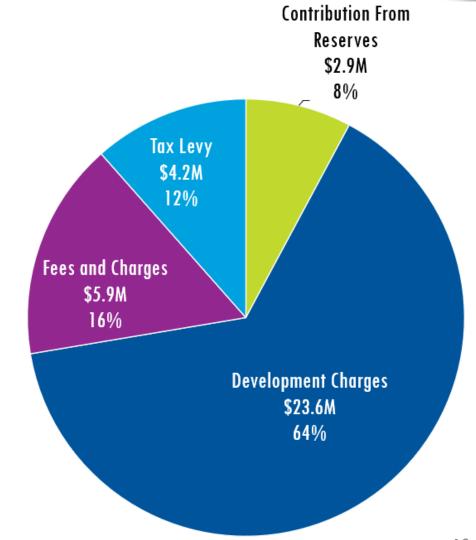


THE BUDGET IS FUNDED THROUGH TAX AND NON-TAX REVENUES
