





Network in 2018




HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE 2024-26 BUDGET

Expansion project underway, facilitating digital equity across the Region




OPERATING BUDGET

YORKNET'S BUDGET IS 0.2% OF THE REGION'S EXPENDITURES






YORKNET'S BUDGET IS 0.2¢ OF THE REGION'S TAX DOLLAR




TEN-YEAR CAPITAL PLAN IS 1.1% OF THE REGION'S PLAN

YorkNet's 2024 ten-year capital plan is \$122.3M, of which 99.2% is for growth project and 0.8% is for asset management






