







## COVID-19, Influenza, RSV all Contributing to Burden

#### New Admissions to Hospital for COVID-19, Influenza, RSV




# COVID-19 Today in Perspective

Confirmed COVID-19 patients not in ICU




Confirmed COVID-19 patients in ICU

## COVID-19 has Likely Peaked




# Updated (<6mo) Vaccination Rate High in Seniors

#### Other Public Health Achievements

- Ensuring students have routine vaccines for first time since pandemic
  - Public Health is collecting immunization information online via Immunization Connect Ontario
  - Applying provincial Immunization of School Pupils Act in 7-8 year-olds in publicly funded boards
- Grade 7 Hep B, HPV and Meningococcal vaccination program
  - On track to meet or exceed coverage compared to 2022/2023 school year
- Unprecedented Invasive Group A Strep cases and deaths in Ontario
  - Levels are high in the Province (222 cases in Ontario in December 2023)
  - York Region had nine cases in December 2023 and four cases to date in January 2024
- 100% of required inspections complete
  - Food premises, spas, pools, personal service settings, and fridges holding publicly funded vaccines
- Opioid Action Plan updated and released January 2024
