Regional Councillor Vegh made the following acknowledgement:

We acknowledge that York Region is located on the traditional territory of many Indigenous peoples including the Anishinaabeg, Haudenosaunee, Huron-Wendat and Métis peoples and the treaty territories of the Haudenosaunee, Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation and Williams Treaties First Nations.

Today this area is home to many diverse Indigenous Peoples, and we recognize their history, spirituality, culture and stewardship of this land.

We also acknowledge the Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation as our closest First Nation community.

E. Accessibility Updates

E.1 Update on Accessibility Activities

Committee received the following verbal updates from Kim Bacani-Angus, Lead, Inclusion, Diversity, Equity and Accessibility (IDEA), People, Equity and Culture, Office of the CAO:

Accessibility Compliance Report

The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act requires the submission of an Accessibility Compliance Report every two years. 2023 was a reporting year and the Region's submission reported 100% compliance.

AODA

Accessibility legislation also dictates that the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act* must be reviewed every four years. Rich Donovan, CEO of the Return to Disability Group, was appointed as the reviewer and conducted public consultations through 2022 and 2023. In December 2023 the final report was published, which includes a number of recommendations to the Province of Ontario.

2023 to 2027 Multi-Year Accessibility Plan

Regional Council approved the 2023 to 2027 Multi-Year Accessibility Plan in November 2023. Updates will be provided on how York Region and York Regional Police are meeting actions in the Plan in the 2024 Annual Status Report at the end of this year.

Annual Member Review Meetings

As per the terms of reference for this committee, membership will be reviewed and evaluated annually by staff based on the ability of members to carry out advisory duties, attendance, participation, legislative requirements, and a member's ability to fulfill the requirements as outlined in the Membership Responsibility Agreement.
