Re: 2023 Disposal of Surplus Assets

This memorandum ('memo') advises Council of tangible capital assets disposed as surplus assets, and the associated gain or loss, excluding land, buildings and furniture, pursuant to the <u>Disposal of Surplus Assets Policy</u> ('Policy').

## The Policy ensures recovery of maximum residual value through surplus asset disposal

Surplus assets refer to tangible capital assets that are obsolete, no longer needed, or no longer usable, as determined by the relevant Commissioner. The Policy does not apply to disposal of land, buildings, and furniture.

Disposal occurs when a department relinquishes ownership of a Regional asset through sale, destruction, loss or abandonment, resulting in the cost and accumulated amortization of the asset being reduced to zero.

The Procurement Office Director has delegated authority to approve the disposal of Regional surplus assets using a method that recovers maximum residual value.

# In 2023, disposal of 95 surplus assets generated net proceeds of \$806,258

Through the Policy, the Procurement Office is responsible for annual reporting to Council on the disposal of surplus assets.

This memo advises Council of the disposal of surplus assets with associated proceeds from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023, including:

- 12 decommissioned ambulances with net proceeds of \$276,000
- 34 decommissioned buses with net proceeds of \$178,356
- 1 decommissioned equipment with net proceeds of \$3,448
- 48 decommissioned vehicles with net proceeds of \$348,454

# The Policy prescribes methods of disposal to recover maximum residual value

Intention to dispose of surplus assets is collected from Regional departments as required by public sector accounting standards, through the following methods, in the order listed below:

- 1. Trade-in the asset
- 2. Offer the asset free of charge to other Regional departments
- 3. Offer the asset at its net residual value to local municipalities
- 4. Sell the asset through a competitive commercial mechanism, such as through a competitive bid or auction, in an open and transparent process

Where applicable, assets may be disposed of through Stewardship Ontario (formerly the Ontario Stewardship Program), a not-for-profit organization whose primary objective is to keep materials out of landfills and to recover as much value as possible from assets at the end of their useful life.

If the above methods of disposal are unsuccessful or deemed inappropriate, the Procurement Office, in consultation with the relevant Regional department, will determine the most appropriate method of disposal in an environmentally sustainable manner.

If the asset is of a nominal value, it may be donated for charitable or benevolent purposes at the discretion of the relevant Commissioner.

Upon disposal, the assets and any remaining net book value (historical cost less amortization) are removed from the Region's balance sheet. Net proceeds are transferred to departmental asset replacement reserves, as determined by the Commissioner of Finance.

# Net proceeds of disposed surplus assets resulted in a gain of \$775,428 for two Regional departments

Table 1 shows 95 surplus assets generated \$806,258 in net proceeds. An accounting gain of \$775,428 has been included in the 2023 consolidated financial statements.

<sup>\*</sup> There are instances where the amount presented as the Net Proceeds is different from the Gain of the disposed asset due to potential errors in submitting this information. Where this is the case, Controllership Office, Finance Department, will work with departments to adjust, as necessary, throughout 2024.

The surplus assets presented in Table 1 were disposed through the allowable methods of trade-in or auction. Full details of the disposed of surplus assets can be found in Appendix A.

The gain or loss generated from the disposal of surplus assets is impacted by their condition. For example, mileage and wear-and-tear impact the asset's value and the net proceeds received using one of the Policy's prescribed disposal methods. Accounting losses can occur in disposing of surplus assets but are not considered common. One of the 95 inclusions in this memo had an accounting loss of \$1,101.

Disposed surplus assets typically have no net book value. However, some assets have been disposed of with a remaining net book value. In these instances, departments determined it is not cost-effective to repair and/or maintain the asset. Five of the 95 inclusions in this memo had a cumulative net book value of \$50,182, resulting in a cumulative gain of \$10,643.

In addition to disposing of surplus assets identified in this memo, the Region donated two decommissioned ambulances to Nunavut communities through Ambulances4NU, as approved by Council in <u>April 2022.</u>

There is no local municipal impact associated with this report. No local municipalities expressed an interest in acquiring any of the assets identified in this report at their net residual value.

The Disposal of Surplus Assets Policy identifies the following methods of disposal: Trade-in the asset ("Trade-in"); offer the asset free of charge to other Regional departments ("Offered to other Regional department"); offer the asset at its net residual value to local area municipalities ("Sold to a local area municipality"); self the asset through a competitive commercial mechanism, such as through a competitive of the asset through the personal representative and environmentally sustainable method ("Other - description of method" ("Ithe description of the method will change as applicable))

- 2. Net book value refers to the difference between the cost of a tangible capital asset (TCA) and both its accumulated amortization and the amount of any write-downs. It represents the unconsumed cost of a TCA attributable to its remaining service life.
- 2. Proceeds refers to the money received from the disposal of a surplus asset, using one of the acceptable Methods of Disposal.
- 4. Gain/Loss refers to the gain or loss on disposal.

The gain on disposal is the amount by which the net proceeds realized upon a TCA's disposal exceeds its net book value. The loss on disposal is the amount by which the net book value of a TCA exceeds the net proceeds realized upon the TCA's disposal.
