



\$2.8B* 2019 10-YEAR TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL BUDGET




RECORD INVESTMENT IN ROADS AND TRANSIT PROGRAMS

Roads and Transit Annual Capital Investment




2019-2028 TRANSPORTATION SERVICES CAPITAL BUDGET





The Regional Municipality of York is undertaking a Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to review the current and future transportation needs on Kennedy Road between Steeles Avenue and Major Mackenzie Drive in the City of Markham.

Through the EA study, York Region will review traffic operations and the need for transportation system and infrastructure improvements on Kennedy Road.

Public consultation is an important part of the EA study. York Region welcomes resident and stakeholder feedback throughout the study and will also seek community members to form a stakeholder group. This group will meet at key milestones and provide feedback. 




