Re: **2022–2026 Council Accomplishments**

As the 2022–2026 Council term concludes, this memorandum provides a summary of accomplishments across all service areas, with additional detail on key initiatives, investments, and outcomes included in Attachment 1.

These accomplishments align with York Region’s [2023–2027 Strategic Plan](#) and are reflected in the Region’s annual [Community Reports](#), which track progress toward Council-approved priorities and community outcomes over the term.

Significant accomplishments of the 2022–2026 York Region Council include:

- Strengthening community health, safety, and emergency services by enhancing public health and immunization programs, expanding community paramedicine models that reduce hospital transports, opening new paramedic response stations, and improving emergency preparedness through new digital coordination tools
- Increasing affordable housing options for low and moderate income residents and strengthening homelessness response by creating new community, emergency and transitional housing, and investing more than \$40 million to enable non-profit providers to deliver new affordable rental homes
- Expanding and modernizing the regional transportation system by supporting implementation of the One Fare Program, introducing electric buses and opening new transit terminals, and completing major road renewal, widening and safety improvement projects across the Region
- Delivering critical infrastructure to support growth, sustainability, and service reliability through major investments such as upgrades to the Duffin Creek Plant, expansion of broadband connectivity to underserved homes through YorkNet, and approval of long-term water, wastewater and transportation master plans to support growth to 2051
- Maintaining strong financial stewardship and organizational performance through approval of multi-year budgets and a long-term fiscal strategy, responsible management of a

multi-billion-dollar infrastructure asset portfolio, continued North American recognition for financial reporting excellence, and modernization of customer service and court operations

These accomplishments demonstrate Council's Vision of strong, caring and safe communities through collaboration with local municipalities, community stakeholders, and Regional staff during the 2022–2026 term.
