Delivering transit and addressing congestion



Challenges:

- Toronto Pearson is at the heart of the 2nd largest employment zone in Canada, home to more than 300,000 workers
- Businesses cannot attract workers and workers cannot access good jobs around the airport
- Lack of ground connections means there are more than 1 million car trips per day in and out of the airport employment zone
- Goods are stuck in congestion around the airport
- Only 10% of passengers and employees take transit to get to Pearson; the best in the world do much better – Hong Kong 50%; Schiphol 40%; Shanghai 60%

Toronto Pearson is well situated to connect jobs and innovation centres across the Greater Golden Horseshoe






Nearly twice as many West GTHA commuters travel across the top of the GTA, the "Northern Arc," than to downtown.

 Toronto Region Board of Trade published report Jan 31 endorsing Union Station West as priority infrastructure

Regular planning coordination with federal and provincial officials

 April 10th the Province of Ontario committed to an extension of Eglinton Crosstown to Renforth and to establishing a connection to Toronto Pearson
