# YORK REGION'S 10-YEAR HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS PLAN

#### Since 2014, *Housing Solutions* has provided strategic direction to address York **Region's housing needs**





GOAL 3 **Support home** ownership affordability

GOAL 4 **Strengthen the** homelessness and housing stability system

#### Expected outcomes:

- An integrated service delivery system developed
- Low and moderate income and atrisk households will find and keep appropriate housing

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# YORK REGION'S CURRENT HOUSING CHALLENGES

Housing costs have increased more quickly than incomes



- York Region has the highest proportion of renters who spend 30% or more of their income on rent in the GTA
- Rental housing supply is limited



Lowest proportion of rental housing in the GTA

 More residents are struggling to find and keep housing as the population and economy change



More residents need support to stay housed

# **Common Themes:**

#### 1. Increasing the supply of subsidized and affordable housing

- Financial incentives
- Planning and policy tools
- Creativity and innovation

#### 2. Providing supports that help people stay stably housed

- Addressing a broad range of individual and community needs
- Implementing and expanding programs focused on housing stability
- Education

#### 3. Preventing and reducing homelessness

- Help people find and keep affordable housing
- Training and capacity building
- Coordinate services and plan as a system

## **MAKING PROGRESS ON HOUSING SOLUTIONS GOALS**

*Housing Solutions* will continue to respond to York Region's housing and homelessness needs





Plan for a full mix and range of housing options to support the achievement of complete communities and promote economic development

Implement tools and policies to increase the affordable housing supply

Build community housing and encourage affordable rental housing to meet the housing needs of households with low and moderate income

# **GOAL 2 OBJECTIVES**



Deliver programs that help low and moderate-income residents living in private market housing keep their homes

Support long-term housing stability by strengthening individuals and communities

Advance prevention programs through continuous improvements to help people at risk of homelessness remain stably housed

Strengthen homelessness and housing stability services to help people experiencing homelessness find and keep housing



Sustain the existing stock of community housing

Build an integrated system to plan and deliver homelessness and housing stability services

Conduct research, engagement and knowledge sharing to identify service system gaps and build community capacity in the homelessness and housing stability service system

Encourage and facilitate expansion of long-term care to help residents age in their communities

# **IMPLEMENTING HOUSING SOLUTIONS 2019 TO 2023**

#### **System Indicators**

#### Includes:

- Purpose-built rental vacancy rate
- Market housing affordability
- Subsidized housing wait list and wait times
- Emergency and transitional housing use

#### **Performance Measures**

#### Includes:

- Number of new private purpose-built rental housing units created year over year
- Percentage of clients receiving supports that improve housing stability, year over year
- Number of capacity building activities delivered for housing providers

Specific 2019 and 2020 actions can be funded within existing budget allocations

It is recommended that:

- Council approve Housing Solutions 2019 to 2023
- Housing Solutions be shared with local municipalities and the province
